

#833 Churchill's Mother – Winston Churchill: English on his father's side, American on his mother's side

We will still be dealing with the White Horse Rider and Black Horse Rider and Man o' War (the most recent series), but we are now ready to add <u>Churchill's Mother</u>. The central figure is the American mother of Winston Churchill, Jennie Jerome.

Winston Churchill's father, British statesman Lord Randolph Churchill, was born on February 13, 1849, as the third son of the 7th Duke of Marlborough. Lord Randolph was a brilliant Conservative leader in Britain. In his late 30's, he became Secretary of State for India (1885-1886), Chancellor of the Exchequer (1886), Conservative Leader of the House of Commons (1886-1887), and Leader of the House of Commons (1886-1887). He died young at the age of 45 on January 24, 1895.

Winston Churchill's mother, Jennie Jerome, was born in Brooklyn, New York, on January 9, 1854. She was the daughter of prosperous financier Leonard Jerome, called by newspapers "The King of Wall Street." In 1873, Jennie Jerome would meet Lord Randolph Churchill in England. The romance advanced quickly. They would soon marry and Winston Churchill, their first son, was born on November 30, 1874, at Blenheim Palace.



Key Understanding: Churchill represents both Great Britain and the United States. The Lord intended for Winston Churchill to represent the massive Church-ill theme for both the American and British peoples. He was English on his father's side and American on his mother's side. Churchill embodied and expressed the vitality and national qualities of both

peoples. During World War II and the early years of struggle against Communism that followed, Winston Churchill made himself an indispensable link between the British and American peoples. British-American unity was also the message of his last great book, A History of the English-Speaking Peoples.

Here is #833–Doc 1, a picture of Jennie Jerome Churchill, with her sons Jack (on *her* right) and Winston (on *her* left). Winston Spencer-Churchill was born on November 30,



1874, and John (Jack) Strange Spencer-Churchill was born February 4, 1880.
