Churchill and Man o' War. Winston Churchill is easily tied to Man o' War through his maternal grandfather birthing the Belmont Stakes, and Man o' War becoming the Belmont Stakes' greatest horse.


Key Understanding: Churchill and Man o' War. It makes sense that Churchill and Man o' War go together, for scripture places together that very concept through the understanding that Men of War cannot build the House of God, the true cross-carrying Church. Instead, Men of War build the sword-carrying Church-ill.

1 Chronicles 28:3 (KJV) But God said unto me [King David], <u>THOU SHALT</u> <u>NOT BUILD AN HOUSE FOR MY</u> <u>NAME</u>, BECAUSE THOU HAST BEEN A <u>MAN OF WAR</u>, AND HAST SHED BLOOD.
