

Remember how closely the U.S. Bill of Rights is attached to Revelation 18:2? A good summary is in Unsealing <u>#552</u> The Reagan/Regan-Bush Habitation of Devils – 182 years from *The Exorcist* Bill of Rights to *The Exorcist* of Revelation 18:2.

Revelation 18:1-2 (KJV) And after these things I saw another angel come down from heaven, having great power; and the earth was lightened with his glory. 2 And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, <u>BABYLON THE GREAT</u> IS FALLEN, IS FALLEN, AND IS BECOME THE <u>HABITATION OF</u> <u>DEVILS</u>, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird.



There were 182 years (+ 11 days) between the December 15, 1791, birth of *The Exorcist* Bill of Rights and the December 26, 1973, release of *The Exorcist* – in which Regan is demon-possessed – to show that the United States with its 'Ten Horns' Bill of Rights, while playing the role of *The Exorcist* in the eyes of the **Scarlet Beast's Church**, is actually the "*habitation of devils*" as described in Revelation 18:2.

The Scarlet Beast's Lutheran Church. With the understanding that Frederick Augustus Muhlenberg, the son of the founder of the Lutheran Church in America, was the first signer of the Bill of Rights, we can certainly see that the Lutheran Church in America was fully the *Scarlet Beast's* Lutheran Church.

Key Understanding: The first signer of the U.S. Bill of Rights was a Lutheran and was from Trappe, because the U.S. Bill of Rights represents a *snare*, or *trap*, for the Martin Luther Protestant Reformation Church. Let's again use Jeremiah 5:26-27 as our key "snare", or "trap", verse.

Jeremiah 5:26-27 (KJV) <u>FOR AMONG MY PEOPLE ARE FOUND WICKED MEN:</u> <u>THEY LAY WAIT, AS HE THAT SETTETH SNARES: THEY SET A TRAP, THEY</u> <u>CATCH MEN.</u>

27 As a cage is full of birds, so are their houses full of deceit: therefore they are become great, and waxen rich.
