#855 Why Abraham Lincoln was named Abraham – Abraham's Seed (Children) through Isaac reflect the spirit of 'Ye shall be made free from the bondage of sin'; Abraham's Seed (Children) through Ishmael reflect the spirit of 'Ye shall be made free from the bondage of men'


True Christians who are "of the faith, the same are the children of Abraham" (Galatians 3:7). They are Abraham's seed (Galatians 3:29). Abraham Lincoln was ordained to be named Abraham for the purpose of being (and acting as, and fulfilling) a counterfeit of "our father Abraham" (Romans 4:12). The key issue or theme surrounding the person of Abraham Lincoln being a counterfeit of Abraham, the biblical father of faith, is freedom.







Key Understanding #1: The bondage of sin vs. the bondage of men. The true meaning of the passage of John 8:31-47 (below) can be explained this way: the spirit and focus of 'Ye shall be made free from the bondage of sin' is counted spiritually as if Abraham's seed (children) are through Isaac, while the spirit and focus of 'Ye shall be made free from the bondage of men' is counted spiritually as if Abraham's seed (children) – even though they may naturally be through

Abraham's seed through <u>Ishmael</u> represents <u>freedom from the bondage of *men*</u>

John 8:31-47 (KJV) Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed;

32 And ye shall know the truth, and THE TRUTH SHALL MAKE YOU FREE.

Isaac – are through *Ishmael*.

- 33 They answered him, <u>WE BE ABRAHAM'S SEED, AND WERE NEVER IN BONDAGE</u> <u>TO ANY MAN</u>: how sayest thou, <u>YE SHALL BE MADE FREE</u>?
- 34 Jesus answered them, Verily, Verily, I say unto you, WHOSOEVER COMMITTETH SIN IS THE SERVANT OF SIN.
- 35 And the servant abideth not in the house for ever: but the Son abideth ever.
- 36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.

37 <u>I KNOW THAT YE ARE ABRAHAM'S SEED</u> [through Isaac]; <u>but ye seek to kill me</u>, because my word hath no place in you. [Therefore, though you are still Abraham's seed, it is spiritually as if you are Abraham's seed through Ishmael.]

38 I speak that which I have seen with my Father: and ye do that which ye have seen with your father.

39 They answered and said unto him, Abraham is our father. Jesus saith unto them, <u>IF YE WERE</u>
<u>ABRAHAM'S CHILDREN</u> [through Isaac, and with the true faith of Abraham], <u>YE WOULD DO</u>
THE WORKS OF ABRAHAM.

40 <u>But now ye seek to kill me</u>, a man that hath told you the truth, which I have heard of God: this did not Abraham. [Therefore, though you are still Abraham's seed in the natural through Isaac, it is spiritually as if you are Abraham's seed through Ishmael.]

41 Ye do the deeds of your father. Then said they to him, We be not born of fornication; we have one Father, even God.

42 Jesus said unto them, If God were your Father, ye would love me: for I proceeded forth and came from God; neither came I of myself, but he sent me.
43 Why do ye not understand my speech? even because ye cannot hear my word.

44 Ye are of your father the devil [and spiritually as

if you are Abraham's seed through Ishmael], and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it. 45 And because I tell you the truth, ye believe me not.

46 Which of you convinceth me of sin? And if I say the truth, why do ye not believe me? 47 He that is of God heareth God's words: **ye therefore hear them not, because ye are not of God**.

Key Understanding #2: Stated in a slightly different manner from Key Understanding #1 above, but still reflective of the same basic conclusions, it can be said that the true meaning of the passage of John 8:31-47 (above) can also be explained this way: just as Abraham had natural seed through Isaac, and natural seed through Ishmael, the point is ultimately being made that Abraham has spiritual seed (children) through Isaac by faith, reflected through the spirit and focus of 'Ye shall be made free from the bondage of sin,' while Abraham (Abram) also has spiritual seed (children) through Ishmael, reflected through the spirit and focus of 'Ye shall be made free from the bondage of men.'

Don't Miss This: In John 8:31-47 (*above*), Jesus Christ is counting the Jews, though they are of the natural seed of *Isaac*, as if they were of the natural seed of *Ishmael*, for they *spiritually* were "not of God." Likewise, the 'new birth of freedom' seed (children) of

Abraham Lincoln are counted *spiritually as if* they are Abraham's (Abram's) seed through *Ishmael*.

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
