#902 The Second Babel's One Language and One Speech – These Have One Mind

Genesis 11:1 (KJV) And THE WHOLE EARTH WAS OF ONE LANGUAGE, and ONE SPEECH [Woodrow Wilson's April 2, 1917, 'The World Must Be Made Safe for Democracy' Speech].

The Ten Horns are Ten Kings. This is a lot to absorb, but let's do it, one sentence at a time. The Beast out of the Pit in Revelation 17 has "ten horns" which are "ten kings" (Revelation 17:12, below). These ten horns on the Beast out of the Pit are the same as the ten horns on the Beast out of the Sea in Revelation 13:1 that are crowned (as ten kings). [Reference Unsealings #217—#237, The Ten Horns of Revelation 13:1.] The ten horns which are ten kings are the U.S. Bill of Rights, the crowning event in the establishment of the democratic representative government of the United States of America. The Bill of Rights had no power as kings and no kingdom (Revelation 17:12) until they were crowned on December 15, 1791, becoming a part of the foundation of the U.S. government. The crowning of the Bill of Rights represented the crowning of "the people" as kings.

These have one mind. As we have learned, even incorporating Frederick Muhlenberg, the first signer of the Bill of Rights, into the picture, the U.S. Constitution represents the unifying of the colonies/states into the United States, a *national second* Babel. The people of the *national second* Babel have "one language" and "one speech" <u>politically</u>, that of creating a worldwide second Babel by Making the World Safe for Democracy. They are of "one mind."

Before we continue on, let's review the question posed in Unsealing #885 in association with 1 Corinthians 1:17 (NIV) For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the gospel—NOT WITH WORDS OF HUMAN WISDOM, lest the cross of Christ be emptied of its power.

Key Understanding: These have one mind. The words "these [the crowned Bill of Rights] have <u>one mind</u>" in Revelation 17:13 simply reflect the Genesis 11 <u>one language</u>, <u>one speech</u>, and <u>one purpose</u> of the people of the second Babel, which are to exalt the will of the people, institute government of the people, by the people, for the people, and Make the World Safe for Democracy.



The crowned Bill of Rights fulfilling "these have one mind" in Revelation 17:13 reflect the philosophies from the Enlightenment Era/Age of Reason (*left*), not the "mind of Christ" that is given to cross-carrying men by the Holy Spirit.

Revelation 17:10-13 (KJV) And there are seven kings: five are fallen, and one is, and the other is not yet come; and when he cometh, he must continue a short space.

11 And <u>THE BEAST</u> that was, and is not, even he <u>IS THE EIGHTH</u>, and is of the seven, and goeth into perdition.

12 And the <u>TEN HORNS</u> [Bill of Rights] which thou sawest are <u>TEN KINGS</u>, which have received no kingdom as yet; but receive power as kings one hour with the beast.

13 <u>THESE</u> [the crowned Bill of Rights, representing "the people"] <u>HAVE ONE MIND</u> [one purpose], and shall give their power and strength unto the beast. [We the People, represented by the Bill of Rights, give their power – "people power" – to the Beast, America. They are of "one language" and "one speech," to Make the World Safe for Democracy.]
