
#912 The Woman is that Great City Babylon, II – Revelation 17:18 and 1918

Revelation 17:18 (KJV) And THE WOMAN which thou sawest IS THAT GREAT CITY [Babylon the Great], which reigneth over the kings of the earth [by Making the World Safe for Democracy].

Although the 19th Amendment was not passed until August 26, 1920, it was in 1918 that the Woman's Movement gained its real successes toward that goal.



Woodrow Wilson changed course in 1918. The Woman's Movement needed the support of President Woodrow Wilson in order to successfully pass the 19th Amendment guaranteeing women the right to vote. It was in 1918 that Woodrow Wilson finally gave his support to the suffrage cause. On January 9, 1918, Woodrow Wilson announced his support of the 19th Amendment. The next day, the House of Representatives narrowly passed the amendment. The Senate, however, refused to even debate it until October. In September 1918, Woodrow Wilson strongly encouraged the Senate to pass the measure.

World War I ended in 1918. The war in which women participated, and which helped them "earn" the right to vote, ended on November 11, 1918.

The elections of 1918. The elections in the fall of 1918 were significant in finalizing the change of Congress toward prosuffrage. In response to the recent poor Senate vote on the issue, the National Woman's Party urged citizens to vote against anti-suffrage senators up for election in the fall of 1918. After the 1918 elections, most members of Congress were pro-suffrage.

The 2-month change and Revelation 17:18 and 1918. We have covered the 2-month change many times before, beginning in Unsealing #242. The 2-month change is used again by the Lord in correlating Revelation 17:18 with 1918.

Just as 4:2 = April 2 = June 2 = 6:2 (we are using this as an example), and just as 7:18 = July 18= September 18 = 9:18 (again, an example), the Lord likewise continues the pattern with 17:18 having an equivalency to 19:18.

17:18 and 1918

Key Understanding: 17:18 and 1918. Although the 19th Amendment was not passed until August 26, 1920, it was in 1918 that the Woman's Movement gained its real successes toward that goal. The Lord chose the year 1918 to significantly fulfill Revelation 17:18.
