

## #914 The Woman is that Great City Babylon, II – *Two* James Wilsons prophetically connected with Woodrow Wilson, part 1, The Death of James Wilson on August 26, 1920

**The Double Wilsons.** In Unsealing #892, we discussed the double Wilsons as concerned the *first step* of Benjamin Franklin/*James Wilson* in the building of a *single democratic nation* Second Babel to the *second step* of *Woodrow Wilson* in building a *worldwide* Second Babel.








**Double James Wilsons.** We are now ready to discuss that for the purpose of confirming prophecy, the Lord ordained a *first* James Wilson to be attached to the *first step* of the building of a *single democratic nation* Second Babel, and then ordained a *second* James Wilson to be attached to the *second step* of Woodrow Wilson building a *worldwide* Second Babel.

**The first James Wilson.** We were introduced to the *first* James Wilson (*above left*) in Unsealing #892. He was one of only six men to sign both the Declaration of Independence and the U.S. Constitution. He was also a U.S. Supreme Court Justice (1789-1798).

The second James Wilson. The second James Wilson became the longest-serving cabinet secretary – sixteen years – in the history of America. President McKinley named James Wilson of Iowa the Secretary of Agriculture in 1897. He remained the Secretary of Agriculture from March 4, 1897, to March 3, 1913, through the presidencies of Theodore Roosevelt and William Howard Taft. It was only when, in 1912, a Democrat – Woodrow Wilson – was elected president that James Wilson ceased to be in that office, at the age of 78. James Wilson died on August 26, 1920, the very day the 19<sup>th</sup> Amendment was added to the U.S. Constitution.

Key Understanding: *Two James Wilsons*. The Lord ordained *double* James Wilsons to confirm prophecy. Each was tied to the <u>U.S. Constitution</u>, one more so with <u>Babel</u>, the other more so with <u>Woman</u>.



James Wilson (August 16, 1835 – August 26, 1920)

The <u>first James Wilson</u> and <u>Babel</u> and the <u>U.S. Constitution</u>. The <u>first James</u> Wilson, in close association with Benjamin Franklin, was instrumental in building the <u>single democratic nation</u> Second Babel through the U.S. Constitution of September 17, 1787. We certainly see <u>Babel</u> and the <u>U.S. Constitution</u> with the <u>first James Wilson</u>, because the building of Babel was referred to in Benjamin Franklin's speech that James Wilson read to the Constitutional Convention.

The <u>second James Wilson</u> and <u>Woman</u> and the <u>U.S. Constitution</u>. The <u>second James</u> Wilson died on August 26, 1920, the date the 19<sup>th</sup> Amendment was added to the U.S. Constitution, in association with the prophetic theme of 'the Woman and the <u>worldwide</u> Second Babel.' Because of this, we see **Woman** and the **U.S. Constitution** with the <u>second James</u> Wilson.

Key Understanding (continued): The Lord further showed the link between <u>Woman</u> and <u>Babel</u> through the *first* and *second* James Wilsons.

Revelation 17:18 (KJV) And <u>THE WOMAN</u> which thou sawest <u>IS THAT GREAT CITY</u> [Babylon the Great], which reigneth over the kings of the earth. [This is easily connected to the second James Wilson, who died on August 26, 1920.]

The **Woman** of Revelation 17:18 is tied to **Babel** of Genesis 11:1...

Genesis 11:1 (KJV) And THE WHOLE EARTH WAS OF ONE LANGUAGE, and ONE SPEECH [Woodrow Wilson's April 2, 1917, 'The World Must Be Made Safe for Democracy' Speech]. [This is easily connected to the *first* James Wilson, who read Benjamin Franklin's 'Babel' speech on September 17, 1787.]
