#930 The Woman is also the John Calvin Church/State – The Government upon the shoulders of John Calvin, and John Calvin Coolidge




Key Understanding: The government upon the shoulders of John Calvin, and John Calvin Coolidge. It is important to remember that John Calvin Coolidge is relevant in prophecy in the first place only because of John Calvin. And John Calvin Coolidge's place in Isaiah 9:6, as a counterfeit son with the government "upon his shoulder," is relevant only because the errant doctrines of John Calvin include the church/state idea of the church being able to establish the Lord's government upon the church's shoulder before the Lord's return. The Lord's ordainment of John Calvin Coolidge to have such a name is simply pointing to the attempt by the Calvinistic Protestant Reformation church over the course of time to establish governments of God upon the church's shoulder. The prime example became America as 'One Nation Under God.'

Atlas was sentenced by Zeus to hold up the sky, but the popular images of Atlas depict him holding the earth upon his shoulders, essentially a counterfeit of Isaiah 9:6

Thus, we could look at the combination of the John Calvin-John Calvin Coolidge counterfeit of Isaiah 9:6-7 this way:

Isaiah 9:6 (KJV) FOR UNTO US A CHILD IS BORN [John Calvin, on July 10, 1509], UNTO US A SON IS GIVEN: and THE GOVERNMENT [the Protestant Reformation's establishing of God's government upon the earth, as in 'One Nation Under God'] SHALL BE UPON HIS [John Calvin Coolidge's] SHOULDER [as President of the United States, beginning August 3, 1923, and ending March 4, 1929]: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.



Isaiah 9:7 (KJV) Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

[Note: John Calvin was born on July 10, 1509. On June 11, 1509, exactly 29 days before the birth of John Calvin, representing a "double portion of the spirit," King Henry VIII married Catherine of Aragon, the first of his six wives. The two events are prophetically tied together. This will be discussed later.]
