

#935 The Woman is also the John Calvin Church/State – April 6, 1917: America’s entry into World War I to Make the World Safe for Democracy represented a Woodrow Wilson-led Calvinist Protestant Reformation Latter Day Reign for the Lord upon the earth, in fulfillment of Revelation 17:18

Key Understanding: *The Calvinist Protestant Reformation latter day reign for God. The April 6, 1917, Good Friday entry of America – the Woman, “that Great City” Babylon – into World War I to Make the World Safe for Democracy and attempt to establish a worldwide Second Babel of a Partnership of Democratic Nations, also spiritually and prophetically represented a Woodrow Wilson-led Calvinist Protestant Reformation latter day reign for the Lord “over the kings of the earth,” in fulfillment of Revelation 17:18.*

Ephesians 5:32 (KJV) This is a great mystery: but I speak concerning CHRIST [represented by the man, the husband] AND THE CHURCH [represented by the woman, the wife].

Revelation 17:18 (KJV) And THE WOMAN which thou sawest IS THAT GREAT CITY [Babylon the Great], WHICH REIGNETH OVER THE KINGS OF THE EARTH [by Making the World Safe for Democracy].

We will soon build upon the following understanding:

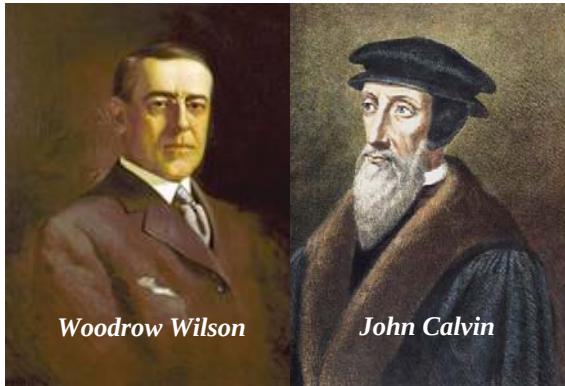

The first phase of the John Calvin Protestant Reformation



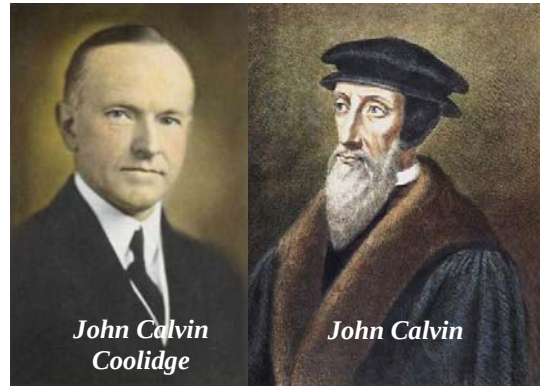
Reformation Wall in Geneva. From left: William Farel, John Calvin, Theodore Beza, and John Knox
