#946 The Whore's Latter Rain - The First Pentecost and the Second Pentecost

This and the next Unsealing are not so much about unsealing and revealing, but are primarily informational.

Key Understanding: *The first Pentecost and the second Pentecost*. To Pentecostals, what occurred in Acts 2 was a *first* Pentecost, while the Azusa Street Revival that began on April 9, 1906, evidenced with the "speaking in tongues," essentially represented a reenactment of Acts 2, and thus a *second*, or very latter day, Pentecost, which gave rise to the latter day Pentecostal movement as a whole.

Acts 2:1-21 (KJV) And when <u>THE DAY OF</u> <u>PENTECOST</u> was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.

2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.

3 And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.

4 And <u>THEY WERE ALL FILLED WITH</u>
<u>THE HOLY GHOST, AND BEGAN TO</u>
<u>SPEAK WITH OTHER TONGUES</u>, as the
Spirit gave them utterance.

5 And there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, out of every nation under heaven

6 Now when this was noised abroad, the multitude came together, and were confounded, because that every man heard them speak in his own language.

7 And they were all amazed and marvelled,

saying one to another, Behold, are not all these which speak Galilaeans?

8 And how hear we every man in our own tongue, wherein we were born?

9 Parthians, and Medes, and Elamites, and the dwellers in Mesopotamia, and in Judaea, and Cappadocia, in Pontus, and Asia,

10 Phrygia, and Pamphylia, in Egypt, and in the parts of Libya about Cyrene, and strangers of Rome, Jews and proselytes,

11 Cretes and Arabians, we do hear them speak in our tongues the wonderful works of God.

12 And they were all amazed, and were in doubt, saying one to another, What meaneth this?


13 Others mocking said, These men are full of new wine.

14 But Peter, standing up with the eleven, lifted up his voice, and said unto them, Ye men of Judaea, and all ye that dwell at Jerusalem, be this known unto you, and hearken to my words:

15 For these are not drunken, as ye suppose, seeing it is but the third hour of the day.

16 BUT THIS IS THAT WHICH WAS SPOKEN BY THE PROPHET JOEL;

17 And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, <u>I WILL POUR OUT MY SPIRIT</u>



<u>UPON ALL FLESH</u>: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams:

18 And on my servants and on my handmaidens <u>I WILL POUR OUT IN THOSE DAYS OF</u> <u>MY SPIRIT</u>; and they shall prophesy:

19 And I will shew wonders in heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke:

20 The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before that great and notable day of the Lord come:

21 And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.
