The Reigning Church. The spirit behind the *Latter Reign* doctrines that are said to have their roots in the April 9, 1906, Azusa Street Revival that birthed the modern day *Latter Rain* Pentecostal/Charismatic/Latter Rain movements, is that a worldwide revival must take place before the Lord will return (or is allowed to return). This revival generally encompasses the Church reigning over the governmental systems of the world now, not through a theocracy, but, quite acceptably, through an extension of the Woodrow Wilson objective of Making the World Safe for Democracy.



"One Nation Under God" American patriotism is a Latter Reign doctrine. Therefore, before we even arrive at listing aberrant "Kingdom Now" Latter Reign doctrines that are perhaps unfamiliar to those outside of the Latter Rain (Pentecostal, Charismatic, Latter Rain Movement) churches, one must understand, as we have emphasized many times before, that the doctrine of "One Nation Under God" is a "Kingdom Now" Latter Reign doctrine. Thus, while many Pentecostals, such as those of the Assembly of God denomination, may not believe they are a part of aberrant "Kingdom Now"




... the "reigning as kings" spirit of the "<u>speaking in tongues</u>" Corinthians seen in 1 Corinthians 4:8...
