## #1048 The Revelation 3:21 Grant – "To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne"

We are moving forward from <u>The Latter Rain of the Cross</u>, with the Holy Spirit to <u>The</u> Revelation 3:21 Grant.

In Revelation 3:21, we see a "grant" by the Lord to those of the Laodicean church:



Revelation 3:21 (KJV) <u>To him that overcometh WILL I</u> <u>GRANT to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame,</u> and am set down with my Father in his throne.

The "grant" by the Lord to those of the Laodicean church – if they overcome – is to sit as a joint-heir with Jesus Christ, who also overcame, to partake of the throne of God.

Key Understanding: The Revelation 3:21 Grant. We are calling the Lord's Revelation 3:21 "grant" – to him that overcometh WILL I GRANT to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne – "the Revelation 3:21 grant."

Here is the entirety of the letter to the church of Laodicea.

Revelation 3:14-22 (KJV) And unto the angel of <u>THE</u> <u>CHURCH OF THE LAODICEANS</u> write; These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God;

15 I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot.

16 So then because thou art

lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth.

17 Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; <u>AND KNOWEST NOT THAT</u> <u>THOU ART</u> wretched, and miserable, and poor, and <u>BLIND</u>, and naked:

18 I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; AND ANOINT THINE EYES WITH EYESALVE, THAT THOU MAYEST SEE.

As a counterfeit of Revelation 3:21, and pointing through Revelation chapters 4 and 5 to Revelation 6:1-2 and the opening of the seven seals, Constantine sat on his father's (Constantius's) throne.
