<u>#1058 The Revelation 3:21 Grant – The Church of Laodicea must give up "people's rights"</u> to be "given the right" to sit on the Father's throne

While Revelation 3:21 in the KJV reads like this . . .

Revelation 3:21 (KJV) <u>To him that overcometh WILL I GRANT to sit with me in my</u> throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my father in his throne....


Revelation 3:21 in the NIV reads like this . . .

*Revelation 3:21 (NIV) <u>To him who overcomes, I WILL GIVE THE RIGHT to sit with me</u> on my throne, just as I overcame and sat down with my Father on his throne.* 

"Will I grant" in the KJV translates to "I will give the right" in the NIV.

Key Understanding #1: *I will give the right*. The church in Laodicea prophetically represents the "church of people's rights" (Unsealing <u>#11</u>), leading us to understand the Lord-ordained irony that "will *I grant*" in the KJV is translated as "*I will give the <u>right</u>*" in the NIV.

Key Understanding #2: Why the Lord worded Revelation 3:21 to read, "I will give the <u>right</u>..." The "church of 'people's rights"" – that is, the church of Laodicea – must overcome the doctrine of "people's rights" in order to be "given the right" to sit on the Father's throne.

This clearly correlates with the fact that the ten horns crowned atop the beast (Revelation 13:1) are the Bill of Rights. The church of Laodicea must spiritually give up their enthroned <u>Bill of Rights</u> to be given the <u>right</u> to sit with Jesus Christ with his Father on his throne.
