#1070 The Door of Heaven and the Gate of God – The Two Eliakims: The church of Philadelphia has an *open door* to sit on the *throne of David* with Jesus Christ, while the church of Laodicea must overcome and *open the door* to sit on the *throne of David* with Jesus Christ

Key Understanding #1: The two themes of (i) an <u>open door into heaven</u> and (ii) the <u>throne of David</u> and/or the <u>throne of the Father</u> are paired together <u>twice</u> in Revelation 3 in the letters to the church of Philadelphia and to the church of Laodicea.

Key Understanding #2: The church of Philadelphia <u>has</u> overcome, and has an <u>open door</u> to sit on the <u>throne of David</u> with Jesus Christ, while the church of Laodicea <u>must yet</u> overcome and <u>open the door</u> to sit on the <u>throne of David</u> with Jesus Christ.

Revelation 3:7-8 (KJV) And to the angel of the <u>church in Philadelphia</u> write; These things saith he that is holy, he that is true, <u>he that hath THE KEY OF DAVID</u> [which can be equated with sitting on the throne of David], <u>he that openeth</u>, and no man shutteth; and <u>shutteth</u>, and no man openeth;

8 I know thy works: behold, <u>I have set before thee AN OPEN DOOR</u>, and no man can shut <u>it</u>: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name.

Revelation 3:20-21 (KJV) Behold, <u>I stand at the door</u>, and knock: <u>if any man hear my</u> <u>voice</u>, <u>and OPEN THE DOOR</u>, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me. 21 <u>To him that overcometh WILL I GRANT to sit with me IN MY THRONE</u>, even as I <u>also overcame</u>, and am set down with my father IN HIS THRONE.

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
