

#1143 The Curse of Jehoiakim and the Lineage of Jesus Christ – Genealogy chart with the assumption that Salathiel (Shealtiel) and Zerubbabel are the same set of persons in both Matthew's and Luke's genealogies


Question: Are the persons of Salathiel (Shealtiel) and Zerubbabel who are listed in Matthew's genealogy (Matthew 1:12), with Zerubbabel clearly being the Zerubbabel who was the primary builder of the Second Temple, the same as the persons of Salathiel (Shealtiel) and Zerubbabel who are listed in Luke's genealogy (Luke 3:27), or are they a different set of two persons whom God ordained to have the same names? This has been a significant question concerning the genealogies of Jesus Christ.





Key Understanding: Salathiel and Zerubbabel. Below (on the second page) is a typical genealogy chart that reflects the assumption that Salathiel (Shealtiel) and Zerubbabel are the same set of persons in both Matthew's genealogy through Joseph and Luke's genealogy through Mary. Therefore, the genealogies are shown converging through Salathiel (Shealtiel) and Zerubbabel. For both genealogies, the chart is abbreviated to begin with King David and end with Jesus.
