

#1160 The Curse of Jehoiakim and the Lineage of Jesus Christ – The two *second phases* of the Jeremiah 36:30 curse upon the *second* Eliakim (King Jehoiakim)

Key Understanding: *The two second phases of the Jeremiah 36:30 curse upon the second Eliakim (King Jehoiakim).* We have actually studied what can be called two second phases of the Jeremiah 36:30 curse upon the *second* Eliakim (King Jehoiakim). The first second phase was that of the curse upon Jehoiachin (Jeconiah, Coniah), Jehoiakim's son. The second second phase is the Malachi 4:6 curse associated with Elijah. Thus, the first second phase is tied to the second second phase because . . . the “earth, earth, earth” cursed Jehoiakim-Jehoiachin bloodline with the curse(s) of “none to sit upon the throne of David” in Old Testament times points to the “earthy, earthy, earthy” cursed Adamic race of mankind as a whole, who cannot sit on the throne with Jesus Christ in eternity, unless they overcome as Jesus Christ overcame, as stated in Revelation 3:21.

The Jeremiah 36:30 curse upon the *second* Eliakim (Jehoiakim) . . .

Jeremiah 36:30 (KJV) Therefore thus saith the LORD of JEHOIAKIM king of Judah; HE SHALL HAVE NONE TO SIT UPON THE THRONE OF DAVID: and his dead body shall be cast out in the day to the heat, and in the night to the frost.

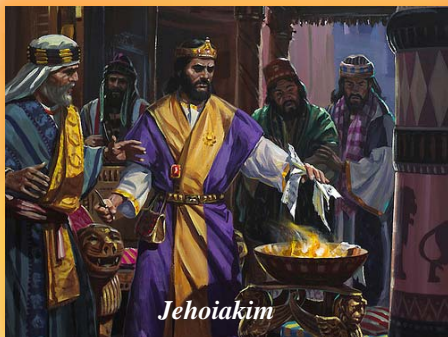
. . . had a *second phase*, which was . . .

The Jeremiah 22:30 curse upon Jehoiachin (Jeconiah, Coniah)

Jeremiah 22:24, 29-30 (KJV) As I live, saith the LORD, though Coniah the son of Jehoiakim king of Judah were the signet upon my right hand, yet would I pluck thee thence;

29 O EARTH, EARTH, EARTH, hear the word of the LORD.

30 Thus saith the LORD, Write ye this man childless, a man that shall not prosper in his days: FOR NO MAN OF HIS [Jehoiachin's] SEED SHALL PROSPER, SITTING UPON THE THRONE OF DAVID, AND RULING ANY MORE IN JUDAH.



Both King Jehoiakim (Jeremiah 36:30) and his son, King Jehoiachin (Jeremiah 22:30), were under a curse from God that their seed would not sit on the throne of David.



(2) The second (2nd) second phase of the Jeremiah 36:30 curse upon the second Eliakim (King Jehoiakim). [Reference Unsealing [#1089](#).]

The prophetic relationship between the second Eliakim (Jehoiakim) and the ‘Two Witnesses’ Elijah manifests itself through a second phase of the Jeremiah 36:30 curse of the second Eliakim (Jehoiakim) becoming the fulfillment of the threatened curse mentioned in Malachi 4:6, which is associated with the ‘Two Witnesses’ Elijah.

The Jeremiah 36:30 curse upon the second Eliakim (Jehoiakim) . . .

Jeremiah 36:30 (KJV) Therefore thus saith the LORD of Jehoiakim king of Judah; HE SHALL HAVE NONE TO SIT UPON THE THRONE OF DAVID: and his dead body shall be cast out in the day to the heat, and in the night to the frost.

The Malachi 4:6 curse associated with Elijah, and with the church of Laodicea

Malachi 4:5-6 (KJV) Behold, I WILL SEND YOU ELIJAH the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD: 6 And he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers, LEST I COME AND SMITE THE EARTH WITH A CURSE.

Revelation 3:20-21 (KJV) Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and OPEN THE DOOR, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.

21 To him that overcometh WILL I GRANT to sit with me IN MY THRONE, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my father IN HIS THRONE.
