Daniel chapter 2, about 604 B.C. – Nebuchadnezzar's Image

Daniel 2:31-32 (KJV) Thou, O king, sawest, and behold a great image. This great image, whose brightness was excellent, stood before thee; and the form thereof was terrible. 32 This image's HEAD WAS OF FINE GOLD [Babylon], <u>HIS</u> <u>BREAST AND HIS ARMS OF SILVER</u> [Media-Persia], HIS BELLY AND HIS THIGHS OF BRASS [Alexander the Great's Greece],

Daniel 2:39 (KJV) And after thee shall arise <u>ANOTHER</u> <u>KINGDOM INFERIOR TO THEE</u> [Media-Persia], and another THIRD KINGDOM OF BRASS [Alexander the Great's Greece], which shall bear rule over all the earth.

Daniel chapter 7, about 553 B.C. – The Four Great Beasts

Daniel 7:3, 5 (KJV) And <u>FOUR GREAT BEASTS</u> <u>CAME UP FROM THE SEA</u>, diverse one from another. 5 And behold <u>ANOTHER BEAST, A SECOND</u> [Media-Persia], <u>LIKE TO A BEAR</u>, and it raised up itself on one side [referring to the superior status of the Persians in the Media-Persia alliance because of the conquering of the Medes by the Persians], and <u>IT HAD</u> <u>THREE RIBS</u> [Lydia (547 B.C.), Babylon (539 B.C.), Egypt (525 B.C.)] <u>IN THE MOUTH OF IT</u>



BETWEEN THE TEETH OF IT: and they said thus unto it, Arise, devour much flesh.

Daniel chapter 8, about 551 B.C. - The Ram and the He Goat

Daniel 8:3 (KJV) Then I lifted up mine eyes, and saw, and, behold, there stood before the river <u>A RAM</u> <u>WHICH HAD TWO HORNS</u>: and the two horns were high; but ONE [Persia] WAS HIGHER THAN THE OTHER [Media], and the higher came up last [reflecting the rise of the Persian Empire after the Median Empire]. {the other: Heb. the second}





Daniel chapter 5, about 539 B.C. – The Writing on the Wall

Daniel 5:25-28 (KJV) And this is the writing that was written, MENE, MENE, TEKEL, UPHARSIN. 26 This is the interpretation of the thing: <u>MENE; God hath numbered thy kingdom, and finished it.</u> 27 <u>TEKEL; Thou art weighed in the balances, and art found wanting.</u> 28 <u>PERES; Thy kingdom is divided, and given to the Medes and Persians.</u>



Revelation chapter 17 – The Seven Heads of the Beast

Revelation 17:10-11 (KJV) And there are seven kings: <u>FIVE</u> [Egypt, <u>Assyria</u>, <u>Babylon</u>, <u>Medo-</u> <u>Persia</u>, Greece] <u>ARE FALLEN</u>, and ONE IS [the Sixth Kingdom, the Roman Empire, and as in Daniel 2:40, extending through the Byzantine, Russian, German, and Austrian Empires to the end of World War I], and THE OTHER [the Seventh Kingdom(s)] IS NOT YET COME; and when he cometh, he [the Seventh Kingdom(s)] must continue A SHORT SPACE. 11 And THE BEAST that was, and is not, even HE IS THE EIGHTH, and is of the seven, and goeth into perdition.
