<u>#1222 America as Media-Persia – The Civil War: The Army of the Medes, led by General</u> <u>George Meade</u>

Key Understanding #1: *The Civil War revealing America as a second Media-Persia*. Starting with this Unsealing and the topic of the Civil War, we will outline exactly how the Lord designed historical events to unfold in the Civil War, World War I, World War II, the Cold War, and the Iraq War so as to reveal America to be the *second* Media-Persia.

The Army of the Potomac. One of the Union armies during the Civil War was called the Army of the Potomac. It was the principal army of the Eastern Theatre. It was responsible for protecting Washington D.C., which sits on the Potomac River. The Army of the Potomac was the Union army that fought at the Battle of Gettysburg, and was one of two major Union armies (the other was the Army of the James) present at the surrender of Robert E. Lee's Confederate army, the Army of Northern Virginia.

General George Meade. General George Meade was given command of the Army of the Potomac on June 28, 1863, just three days before the July 1-3, 1863, Battle of Gettysburg. Meade remained Commander of the Army of the Potomac through June 28, 1865, after the end of the Civil War. Union General U.S. Grant, the final commander of the entire Union Army, located his headquarters with and supervised the Army of the Potomac from May 1864 to April 1865, providing operational direction, though Meade retained formal command.



Key Understanding #2: *The army of Meade*. The Lord designed that Union General George Meade be given command of the Army of the Potomac in time for the July 1863 Battle of Gettysburg, and remain in command of the Army of the Potomac, with U.S. Grant locating his headquarters with and supervising Meade's army, so as to represent the victorious U.S. Grant/Abraham Lincoln-led Union Army as the Army of the Medes.
