## The November 2, 1917, Balfour Declaration



In the midst of World War I, the Balfour Declaration was made in a November 2, 1917, letter from British Foreign Secretary Arthur James Balfour to Lord Rothschild (Walter Rothschild, 2<sup>nd</sup> Baron Rothschild), a leader of the British Jewish Community. The letter stated the position agreed upon at a British Cabinet meeting on October 31, 1917, that the British government – upon the defeat of the Ottoman Turks – supported Zionist plans for a Jewish "national home" in Palestine, with the condition that nothing should be done which might prejudice the rights of existing communities there.

Dear Lord hothschild,
I have much pleasure in conveying to you, on
oshalf of his hulesty's Government, the following
declaration of someable with jewine liceniat aspirations
which has been substited to, and approved by, the Coultest
"Mis lajesty's Government view with favour the
setablishment in Nulestine of a national home for the
jewine pepple, and will use that jest schevure to
facilitate the schievement of this odject, it being
clearly understood that nothing shall be done which
may projecte the civil and religious rights of
existing non-wealth communities in releavine, or the
rights and political status enjoyed by Jews in any
other country".
I school be greateful if you would bring this
ischaration to the knowledge of the Zienist Pederation.
