#1263 Israel as the Fig Tree – Habakkuk 3:17 and "the fig tree shall not blossom" is referring to the same event as the invasion of the Locust Army of Nebuchadnezzar's Babylon in Joel 1 and 2 that causes the fig trees to languish

Key Understanding: The devastating results upon Judah because of the invasion by the "march kings" - the Chaldeans, meaning Nebuchadnezzar's army - which were expected by Habakkuk and seen in Habakkuk 3:17, are described in similar terms as the results of the (same) invasion by the locust army of Nebuchadnezzar that is seen in Joel chapters 1 and 2. The point is that there is a consistent use of the fig tree not budding/blossoming concerning the invasion of Judah by Babylon and the deportations and captivity of the inhabitants of Jerusalem and Judah.

Habakkuk 3:17-18 (KJV) ALTHOUGH THE FIG TREE SHALL NOT BLOSSOM, neither shall fruit be in the

vines; the labour of the olive shall fail, and the fields shall yield no meat; the flock shall be cut off from the fold, and there shall be no herd in the stalls: {fail: Heb. lie} 18 Yet I will rejoice in the LORD, I will joy in the God of my salvation.

*Joel 1:4-12 (KJV)* That which the palmerworm hath left hath the locust eaten; and that which the locust hath left hath the cankerworm eaten; and that which the cankerworm hath left hath the caterpiller eaten. {That which the palmerworm...: Heb. The residue of the palmerworm}

5 Awake, ye drunkards, and weep; and howl, all ye drinkers of wine, because of the new wine; for it is cut off from your mouth.

6 For a nation is come up upon my land, strong, and without number, whose teeth are the teeth of a lion, and he hath the cheek teeth of a great lion.

7 He hath laid my vine waste, AND BARKED THE FIG TREE: he hath made it clean bare, and cast it away; the branches thereof are made

11 Be ye ashamed, O ye husbandmen; howl, O ye vinedressers, for the wheat and for the barley; because the harvest of the field is perished.

12 <u>The vine is dried up, AND THE FIG TREE LANGUISHETH</u> [NIV . . . the fig tree is withered]; the pomegranate tree, the palm tree also, and the apple tree, <u>even all the trees of the field, are withered: because joy is withered away from the sons of men.</u>
