#1278 The Mark of the Beast – A second clue: John 6:66

The passage of John 6:53-66 is about the theme of drinking the blood and eating the flesh of Jesus Christ. Whoever eats the flesh of Jesus Christ, and drinks his blood – which is acceptance of the fact that it was Jesus Christ's blood that was shed for man's sins and spiritually sets men free – dwells in Jesus Christ, and has eternal life.

As was noted in Unsealing #865 <u>Drunken with the Blood of the Saints – Drinking the Blood of Jesus Christ</u> . . .

Key Understanding: John 6:66. John 6:66 says that "From that time many of his disciples went back, and walked no more with him." Since this is the only 6:66 verse in the New Testament (though there are 1 Chronicles 6:66, Psalm 66:6, and Isaiah 66:6 in the Old Testament), and since it (John 6:66) has the context



that it does, could the Lord have designed it as such to be connected with and further reveal the 666 Mark of the Beast in Revelation 13:16-18? The answer is 'yes'.

John 6:53-66 (KJV) Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, Verily, I say unto you, Except ye <u>EAT THE FLESH OF THE SON OF MAN</u>, and <u>DRINK HIS BLOOD</u>, ye have no life in you.

54 Whoso EATETH MY FLESH, and DRINKETH MY BLOOD, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day.
55 For MY FLESH IS MEAT INDEED, and MY BLOOD IS

<u>DRINK</u> indeed.
56 He that <u>EATETH MY FLESH</u>, and <u>DRINKETH MY BLOOD</u>, dwelleth in me, and I in him.

57 As the living Father hath sent me, and I live by the Father: so he that eateth me, even he shall live by me.

58 This is that bread which came down from heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead: he that eateth of this bread shall live for ever.

59 These things said he in the synagogue, as he taught in Capernaum.



60 Many therefore of his disciples, when they had heard this, said, This is an hard saying; who can hear it?


61 When Jesus knew in himself that his disciples murmured at it, he said unto them, Doth this offend you?

62 What and if ye shall see the Son of man ascend up where he was before?

63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life. 64 But there are some of you that believe not. For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were that believed not, and who should betray him.

65 And he said, Therefore said I unto you, that no man can come unto me, except it were given unto him of my Father.

66 From that time many of his disciples went back, and walked no more with him.
