## #1297 The Mark of the Beast – Seen Phylacteries vs. the Unseen Mark of the Lord, part 3, Put in your *forehead* – meaning your mind and thoughts – that which was done by the *hand* of the Lord to deliver you

Key Understanding #1: A reminder on your forehead. A major aspect of the figurative language and understanding that surrounds the theme of the Mark of the Lord – a <u>sign</u> on the <u>hand</u> and <u>forehead</u> – in the Old Testament is simply . . . "put in your <u>forehead</u> – meaning your <u>mind</u> and <u>thoughts</u> – that which was done by <u>the mighty hand</u> of the Lord to deliver you." In fact, this fits very well with the words in the NIV of a <u>sign</u> on your <u>hand</u> and a <u>reminder</u> on your <u>forehead</u>. The point is that a <u>reminder</u> has to do with your memory and your <u>mind</u> in your head.



*Exodus 13:9 (NIV) This observance* [the Feast of Unleavened Bread] *will be for you like a* [figurative] <u>SIGN</u> on your <u>HAND</u> and <u>a reminder</u> on your <u>FOREHEAD</u> that the law of the LORD is to be on your lips. For the LORD brought you out of Egypt with <u>HIS MIGHTY</u> <u>HAND</u>.

*Exodus 13:16 (NIV) And it* [the Consecration of the Firstborn (representing the event of the Passover), either through sacrifice or through obtaining release by means of payment] will be like a [figurative] <u>SIGN</u> on your <u>HAND</u> and a symbol on your <u>FOREHEAD</u> that the LORD brought us out of Egypt with <u>HIS MIGHTY HAND</u>."

Deuteronomy 11:18 (KJV) Therefore shall ye lay up these my words in your heart and in

your soul, and bind them for a <u>sign</u> upon your <u>hand</u>, that they may be as frontlets <u>between your</u> <u>eves</u>. [NIV . . . <u>Fix these words of mine in your</u> <u>hearts and minds</u>; tie them as <u>symbols</u> on your <u>hands</u> and bind them on your <u>foreheads</u>.]

Key Understanding #2: The words of Deuteronomy 11:18 make it clear that the ultimate meaning attached to the <u>forehead</u> is that of <u>fixing</u> <u>the Lord's words in your heart and mind</u>.
