Appendix 2 in the book *An Enduring Love* by Farah Pahlavi, the Shah of Iran's wife, exhibits the contents of "The Proclamation of Cyrus the Great," which was recorded on what is called the Cyrus Cylinder, after Cyrus's conquest of Babylon. The Cyrus Cylinder, which would have been used as a foundation stone for a building, was discovered in Ur, Babylon, in a British Museum dig in the 19th century.

The Cyrus Cylinder has been described as the world's first charter of human rights, "predating the Magna Carta by more than one millennium."
