#1343 America as Media-Persia, II – January 20, 1981: The End of the 444-day Iran Hostage Crisis and the simultaneous Inauguration of Ronald Reagan prophetically represented America arising to mature in its role as the second (but counterfeit) 'Cyrus the Great' Media-Persia

W. Bush administrations.
