The death of NBC's David Bloom. NBC's David Bloom, who had served as White House correspondent for the network and had been coanchor of the weekend editions of "Today" since March 2000, died in Iraq on April 6, 2003, of an

apparent pulmonary embolism. Bloom was embedded with the U.S. Army's 3rd Infantry Division outside Baghdad. He and his crew were covering the war from a specially modified tank recovery vehicle that allowed





the broadcasting of live reports, with high-quality video, as the American armored column he was traveling with fought its way northward through the Iraqi desert. Bloom's death was mourned on all networks.
