

Key Understanding: In World War I, <u>Woodrow Wilson and General John Pershing</u> (whose name means *Persian*) led the United States as the *second* (but *counterfeit*) 'Cyrus the Great' Media-Persia that symbolically (through its British ally) dried up the Euphrates River through the defeat of the Ottoman Turks, while <u>Ronald Wilson Reagan</u> is attached to the incomplete 1991 Gulf War defeat of Saddam Hussein's Iraq (in the role of *pretender* Babylon the Great) through his strengthening and maturing of America as the *second* (but *counterfeit*) 'Cyrus the Great' Media-Persia.




Woodrow Wilson (left) and General John Pershing (right) dried up the Euphrates River through the defeat of the Turks
