## Woodrow Wilson and Man o' War

The race horse Man o' War was


named by Mrs. August Belmont, Jr., in honor of his owner/breeder August Belmont, Jr., who served the U.S. in World War I by securing and training horses for service in the military overseas. Man o' War was covered in Unsealings #825—#832. The March 29, 1917, birth of the horse Man o' War, which occurred four (4) days before Woodrow Wilson's April 2, 1917, War Message to the 65<sup>th</sup> Congress, and eleven (11) days before April 9 [= April 6], 1917, was prophetically representing the April 6, 1917, U.S. entry into World War I, and representing the U.S. in prophecy as the Revelation 6:5 Black Horse Rider. [Note: Man o' War was at first simply called "Mahubah's colt" until Mrs. Belmont gave the horse the permanent name of Man o' War.]

Key Understanding #1: Woodrow Wilson and Man o' War. Man o' War, and his owner/breeder August Belmont, Jr., were ordained by the Lord to prophetically represent Woodrow Wilson and the Woodrow Wilson-led 'Men of War' Body of Americans in World War I, whose purpose it was to Make the World Safe for Democracy.

## Ronald Reagan and Man o' War

(Eleanor Robson Belmont) who named Man o' War after her husband, August Belmont, Jr., who served in the U.S. military in World War I, was born on December 13, 1879, in Wigan, England, and died on October 24, 1979, in New York, New York, exactly 11 days before the November 4, 1979, start of the Iran Hostage Crisis. [Note: The gravestone gives the year of birth as 1878, but most sources give the year of birth as 1879.]

Key Understanding #2: Ronald Wilson Reagan and Man o' War. In Unsealing #1218, it was discussed that the Revelation 6:5 Black Horse Rider represents the role of Media-Persia because of its Pair of Balances defeat of pretender Babylon.
