The November 2, 1917, Balfour Declaration



In the midst of World War I, the Balfour Declaration was made in a November 2, 1917, letter from British Foreign Secretary Arthur James Balfour to Lord Rothschild (Walter Rothschild, 2nd Baron Rothschild), a leader of the British Jewish Community. The letter stated the position agreed upon at a British Cabinet meeting on October 31, 1917, that the British government – upon the defeat of the Ottoman Turks – supported Zionist plans for a Jewish "national home" in Palestine, with the condition that nothing should be done which might prejudice the rights of existing communities there.

Foreign Office, November And, 1917.

Dear Lord Rothschild.

I have much pleasure in conveying to you, on schaif of His Majesty's Government, the following declaration of sympathy with Jevish Zioniat aspirations which has been submitted to, and approved by, the Casimet

"His lidgesty's Covernment view with favour the sestablishment in Palestine of a mational home for the patch people, and will use their best endeavours to feoilitate the achievement of this object, it being clearly understood that nothing shall be done which may prefusite the civil and religious rights of existing non-sexish communities in Palestine, or the Pights and political status enjoyed by Jews In any other country.
