## #1397 The relationship between Daniel 2:42 and U.N. Resolution 242 – Toward U.N. Resolution 242, part 1, The Six-Day War

U.N. Resolution 242 was passed by the United Nations Security Council on November 22, 1967. What led to the resolution was the Six-Day War of June 5-10, 1967, fought between Israel and its Arab enemies. The next few Unsealings explain the lead-up to the United Nations Security Council passing U.N. Resolution 242, and what U.N. Resolution 242 was about.

Key Understanding: *The Six-Day War*. The June 5-10, 1967, Six-Day War was fought between Israel on one side and Egypt, Jordan, and Syria on the other side. The war left Israel with the greatest gains a nation had ever achieved from any war fought between the Arabs and the Israelis. The Sinai and Gaza Strip were captured from Egypt. East Jerusalem and the West Bank were captured from Jordan. The Golan Heights was captured from Syria.
