#1413 The Modern-Day (Re)building of the City, the Wall, and the Temple – The (re)building of Jerusalem (and Israel) in the modern times of the 20th-21st Centuries is also prophetically and historically broken down into the components of the rebuilding of (i) the City, (ii) the Wall, and (iii) the Temple, part 1

When Jerusalem and Judah were (re)built in the time of the rule of Media-Persia, the rebuilding focused on (i) the City (of Jerusalem), (ii) the Wall (of Jerusalem), and (iii) the Temple (at Jerusalem).

Key Understanding: The (re)building of Jerusalem in the modern times of the 20<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup> centuries can *also* be broken down into the components of the rebuilding of (i) <u>the City</u>, (ii) <u>the Wall</u>, and (iii) <u>the Temple</u>.

In other words, relevant historical events preceding, including, and following the May 14-15, 1948, birth of Israel having to do with the birth of Israel are prophetically attached to the themes of rebuilding the City of Jerusalem (and the nation of Israel), the Wall (the defenses) of Jerusalem (and the nation of Israel), and the Temple.

Though Isaiah 44:28 does not mention the Wall of Jerusalem, let's continue to utilize it as a key verse because of its references to the City and the Temple.

## <u>part (a)</u>

Isaiah 44:28 (KJV) [Thus saith the Lord] <u>THAT SAITH OF CYRUS, HE IS MY SHEPHERD</u>, and shall perform all my pleasure:

## part (b)

EVEN SAYING TO [the City of] JERUSALEM, THOU SHALT BE BUILT; AND TO THE TEMPLE [at Jerusalem], THY FOUNDATION SHALL BE LAID.
