#1416 The Modern-Day (Re)building of the City, the Wall, and the Temple – Two Cities of Jerusalem: The United States of America as the City of Jerusalem and Jerusalem, Israel, as the City of Jerusalem

As was stated in Unsealing #1413:

Review: When Jerusalem and Judah were (re)built in the time of the rule of Media-Persia, the rebuilding focused on (i) <u>the City</u> (of Jerusalem), (ii) <u>the Wall</u> (of Jerusalem), and (iii) <u>the Temple</u> (at Jerusalem).


The (re)building of Jerusalem in the modern times of the 20th-21st centuries can *also* be broken down into the components of the rebuilding of (i) the City, (ii) the Wall, and (iii) the Temple.

In other words, relevant historical events preceding, including, and following the May 14-15, 1948, birth of Israel *having to do with the birth of Israel* are prophetically attached to the themes of rebuilding the City of Jerusalem (and the nation of Israel), the Wall (the defenses) of Jerusalem (and the nation of Israel), and the Temple.

New Material: However, in order to fully understand the unfolding of history to fulfill prophecy, one must understand that not only do the modern-day city of Jerusalem and the nation of Israel fulfill roles having to do with the themes of rebuilding the City of Jerusalem (and the nation of Israel), the Wall (the defenses) of Jerusalem (and the nation of Israel), and the Temple, but . . .

Key Understanding #1: The United States of America has its *own* role in the prophetic and (demonic) spiritual realm as <u>the City</u> of Jerusalem (and, similarly, and for the same reasons, as 'Israel').

Key Understanding: #2: Thus, with the themes of rebuilding the City of Jerusalem (and Israel) in the last days, there are two earthly Cities of Jerusalem in the prophetic and spiritual realms, (i) the United States of America as the City of Jerusalem (and, similarly, and for the same reasons, as 'Israel'), and (ii) the city of Jerusalem in Israel as the City of Jerusalem, also essentially representing the nation of Israel as a whole. Just as Washington D.C. and the United States of America are used interchangeably, with Washington D.C. representing the entire United States of America, Jerusalem is used interchangeably with Israel and represents the entire nation of Israel.



Key Understanding #3: Keeping in mind the themes of rebuilding the City of Jerusalem (and Israel), the Wall (the defenses) of Jerusalem (and Israel), and the Temple, when the United States is in the role as the City of Jerusalem, the line-up of rebuilding the City, the Wall, and the Temple comes out as rebuilding the City of Jerusalem (America), the Walls (the defenses of America), and the Temple (of America).

Isaiah 44:28 (KJV) [Thus saith the Lord] <u>THAT SAITH OF CYRUS, HE IS MY SHEPHERD</u>, and shall perform all my pleasure:

EVEN SAYING TO JERUSALEM, THOU SHALT BE BUILT; AND TO THE TEMPLE, THY FOUNDATION SHALL BE LAID.
