

Key Understanding #1: While U.S. President Ronald Reagan was building the Wall (the defenses and offenses) of America that would aid in its Pair of Balances defeats of the Soviet Union (the pretender Scarlet Beast of Revelation 17) in the Cold War and Saddam Hussein-led Iraq (the pretender Babylon the Great of Revelation 18) in the 1991 Gulf War, he challenged the leader of the Soviet Union, Mikhail Gorbachev, to "tear down this wall," referring to the Berlin Wall. The dismantling of the Berlin Wall in 1989 would come to symbolize the eventual dismantling of the Warsaw Pact on July 1, 1991, and the Soviet Union itself in December 1991.

Key Understanding #2: It was clear after the fall of the Berlin Wall and the dismantling of the Warsaw Pact that together they had served as <u>a wall of</u> <u>protection</u> for the Soviet Union. When the Berlin Wall and the Warsaw Pact fell, the Soviet Union would fall.
