
#1498 The role of the A-bomb in the Abomination of Desolation – The *sound* association of A-bomb and Abomination





Let's use this opportunity to look at the meaning in *Strong's Concordance* of each of the words of **abomination** and **desolation**.

Matthew 24:15 (KJV) <u>When ve therefore shall see THE ABOMINATION</u> [#946, from #948, in <i>Strong's Concordance] <u>OF DESOLATION</u> [#2050, from #2049, in *Strong's Concordance*] [in conjunction with the Third Temple being constructed through the joining together of the Man o' War 'Living Stones' *Christian* New Israel (the Body of Americans as the Third Temple) and (with) the Man o' War 'Living Stones' *Jewish* new Israel (the Body of Israelis as the Third Temple)], *spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place,* (whoso readeth, let him understand:)

Abomination in Strong's Concordance, #946, from #948

946 bdelugma bdel'-oog-mahfrom 948;AV-abomination 6; 61) a foul thing, a detestable thing1a) of idols and things pertaining to idolatry

948 bdelusso bdel-oos'-so
from a (presumed) derivative of bdeo (to stink);
1) to render foul, to cause to be abhorred
2) abominable
3) to turn one's self away from on account of the stench
4) metaph. to abhor, detest

Desolation in *Strong's Concordance*, #2050, from #2049

2050 eremosis er-ay'-mo-sisfrom 2049;AV-desolation 3; 31) a making desolate, desolation

2049 eremoo er-ay-mo'-o from 2048;
AV-bring to desolation 2, desolate 1, come to nought 1, make desolate 1; 5
1) to make desolate, lay waste
2) to ruin, bring to desolation
3) to despoil one, strip her of her treasures
