#667 The Churchill Saints of Daniel 7:21 – May 10, 1940: Churchill vs. Hitler, part 2, **Hitler's Invasion**

Two interrelated events were taking place simultaneously on May 10, 1940

Friday, May 10, 1940: Churchill. The first was that of Winston Churchill becoming the wartime Prime Minister of Great Britain.

Friday, May 10, 1940: *Hitler*. The second was the launching of Nazi Germany's "Western Campaign" and full-scale invasion of Belgium, Luxembourg, and the Netherlands, as part of the overall invasion of France.





On 10 May 1940 Germany begins its attacks on Western Europe - Holland, Belgium, Luxembourg, and France

To thwart a German invasion, the French had built a defensive system along their border with Germany called the Maginot Line. Opposite the French defenses along the border, Germany had

stationed troops on the so-called Siegfried Line. But Germany would not invade France directly from Germany. Its intent was to sweep into France through Belgium, where France had not extended the Maginot Line. After World War II began, the Low Countries – Belgium, Luxembourg, and the Netherlands – hoped to remain neutral. However, Germany launched a blitzkrieg ("lightning war") against them beginning in the early morning hours of May 10, 1940. The Low Countries immediately requested Allied help, but Luxembourg surrendered in one day, and the Netherlands in five days.

Here is **#667–Doc 1**, which is a map showing **the French Maginot Line of defense** along the French-German border and **the Nazi invasion of the Low Countries**, called Operation Gelb by the Germans.

Key Understanding (which is identical to what is in previous Unsealings <u>#664</u>–<u>#666</u>): *Churchill.* The man considered to be the greatest of all men in England's rich history was Great Britain's World War II wartime prime minister, Winston Churchill. The Lord ordained for Churchill to have such a name and for him to fulfill such a gigantic historical role for the purpose of spiritually/prophetically representing the theme of Church-ill – as in "Church ill," meaning an "ill Church." The saints described in Daniel 7:21, against whom the Little Horn antichrist/antichrist nation prevail(s), are to be called the Church-ill saints, for Winston Churchill was ordained by the Lord to represent himself and other historical figures of antichrist who *make war <u>with</u> the saints*, and <u>spiritually prevail against</u> them.
