

#1528 The role of the A-bomb in the Abomination of Desolation – The 'Rosemary's Baby' Atomic Bomb of August 9, 1945, part 7, The Lord ordained the prominence of the number 89 and date of 8/9 in the story of Rosemary's Baby to further confirm its role in pointing to the August 9, 1945, Pu-239 Media-Persian A-bomb

In *Rosemary's Baby*, the story begins with Guy and Rosemary having had initially signed an agreement to rent a five-room apartment in a geometric white house on First Avenue, but a Mrs. Cortez calls and tells them that a four-room apartment has become available at the Bramford. **The previous tenant in the apartment at the Bramford, Mrs. Gardenia, had recently died at the age of 89.** On Tuesday, August 3, 1965, they arrived at the Bramford to look at the apartment, #7E. While looking, they noticed the unique situation that the closet at the end of the hallway was blocked, this closet being an entrance to an apartment next to them where an older couple lived whose names (they would later learn) were Roman and Minnie Castevet.



Guy and Rosemary decided on the Bramford, signing a two-year lease for apartment #7E on Monday, <u>August 9</u>, 1965. They eventually moved in on Friday, August 27, 1965.

Key Understanding: The Lord ordained the number 89 and date of 8/9 to be prominent in the story of *Rosemary's Baby* to further confirm its role in pointing to the February 9, 1945, birth of Mia Farrow and the six-month-later August 9, 1945, Pu-239 Media-Persian A-bomb.
