
#1565 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The series of 4's (fours) from Alexander the Great to Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 2a, The Four Diadoch Wars

Next in the series of 4's (fours) from Alexander the Great to Antiochus IV Epiphanes comes the understanding that . . .

Key Understanding: *The four Diadoch wars*. There were 4 (four) Diadoch Wars fought between the successors of Alexander the Great, known as the *Diadochi*. The wars are historically called the First Diadoch War, the Second Diadoch War, the Third Diadoch War, and the Fourth Diadoch War.

Here is #1565–Doc 1, about the Diadochi and the Diadoch Wars. The history associated with the Diadoch Wars is quite complex, so the purpose at this time in viewing this article is *not* to learn the history in detail, but to simply see that four Diadoch Wars followed the death of Alexander the Great. In general, simply find within the article the titles . . . First War of the Diadochi, Second War of the Diadochi, Third War of the Diadochi, and Fourth War of the Diadochi. Again, it is *not* necessary to examine the article in detail as concerns the purpose of this Unsealing.

- First War of the Diadochi, 322-320 B.C.
- Second War of the Diadochi, 319-315 B.C.
- Third War of the Diadochi, 314-311 B.C.
- Fourth War of the Diadochi, 308-301 B.C.




Kingdoms of the Diadochi after the Battle of Ipsus (301 B.C.)
