#1573 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The series of 4's (fours) from Alexander the Great to Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 4c, The prophecy surrounding the division of Alexander the Great's Empire into Four Kingdoms – the Kingdoms of Cassander, Lysimachus, Ptolemy, and Seleucus: Daniel 7:6 and the Beast with Four Heads

Key Understanding #1: Alexander the Great in Daniel 7. The purpose of this Unsealing is to see Alexander the Great and the 4 kingdoms of Cassander, Lysimachus, Ptolemy, and Seleucus in <u>Daniel 7</u> (specifically Daniel 7:6).

The lineup of kingdoms in Daniel chapter 7 was seen and discussed previously in Unsealings #197–#198 and #218–#220.

Key Understanding #2: Daniel 7:6 and the beast with four heads. The Beast with Four Heads in Daniel 7:6 is referring to the empire of Alexander the Great and its break-up into the 4 (kingdoms) of Cassander, Lysimachus, Ptolemy, and Seleucus.

Daniel 7 – The Four Beasts, and then the 'Little Horn' Fifth Beast

Daniel 7:1-7 (KJV) In the first year of Belshazzar king of Babylon Daniel had a dream and visions of his head upon his bed: then he wrote the dream, and told the sum of the matters. 2 Daniel spake and said, I saw in my vision by night, and, behold, the four winds of the heaven strove upon the great sea.

3 And FOUR GREAT BEASTS CAME UP FROM THE SEA, diverse one from another.

4 <u>THE FIRST WAS LIKE A LION</u> [Babylon], and had eagle's wings: I beheld till the wings thereof were plucked, and it was lifted up from the earth, and made stand upon the feet as a man, and a man's heart was given to it.

5 And behold ANOTHER BEAST, A SECOND [Media-Persia], LIKE TO A BEAR, and it

raised up itself on one side, and it had three ribs in the mouth of it between the teeth of it: and they said thus unto it, Arise, devour much flesh.

6 After this I beheld, and lo ANOTHER, LIKE A
LEOPARD [Alexander the Great's Grecian Empire],
which had upon the back of it four wings of a fowl; THE
BEAST HAD ALSO FOUR HEADS [the break-up of
Alexander the Great's Empire into the 4 (four)
kingdoms of Ptolemy, Seleucus, Cassander, and
Lysimachus]; and dominion was given to it.

7 After this I saw in the night visions, and <u>BEHOLD A</u> <u>FOURTH BEAST</u> [the Roman Empire], dreadful and terrible, and strong exceedingly; and it had great iron teeth: it devoured and brake in pieces, and stamped the

residue with the feet of it: and it was diverse from all the beasts that were before it; and <u>IT</u> HAD TEN HORNS.

Then the 'Little Horn' Fifth Beast arrives to fulfill its role in history.

Daniel 7:8 (KJV) I considered the [ten] horns, and behold, there came up among them another <u>LITTLE</u> <u>HORN</u> [a Fifth Beast, the United States of America], before whom there were <u>THREE OF THE FIRST</u> <u>HORNS</u> [England, France, and Spain, uprooted by Mexico, which was then uprooted by the United States in the 1846-1848 Mexican War] <u>PLUCKED</u> <u>UP BY THE ROOTS</u>: and, behold, in this horn were eyes like the eyes of man, and <u>A MOUTH</u> SPEAKING GREAT THINGS.
