

**Key Understanding** (the same as is in the previous Unsealing): *Antiochus III and Daniel 8:9.* Antiochus III the Great, the father of Antiochus IV Epiphanes, is prominently and powerfully in the foreground of the desecration of the Temple by Antiochus IV and the fulfillment of Daniel 8:9, for he waxed exceeding great, toward <u>the south</u> (Egypt), toward <u>the east</u> (re-conquering major regions to the east as far as India), and toward <u>the Pleasant Land</u>.


Daniel 8:9 (KJV) <u>And OUT OF ONE OF THEM</u> [the Syrian kingdom of Seleucus, or the Seleucid Empire] <u>CAME FORTH A LITTLE</u> <u>HORN, which waxed EXCEEDING GREAT, toward THE SOUTH,</u> and toward THE EAST, and toward THE PLEASANT LAND

[Antiochus IV Epiphanes, but the verse should be viewed prophetically with his father, Antiochus III the Great, prominently and powerfully in the foreground].
