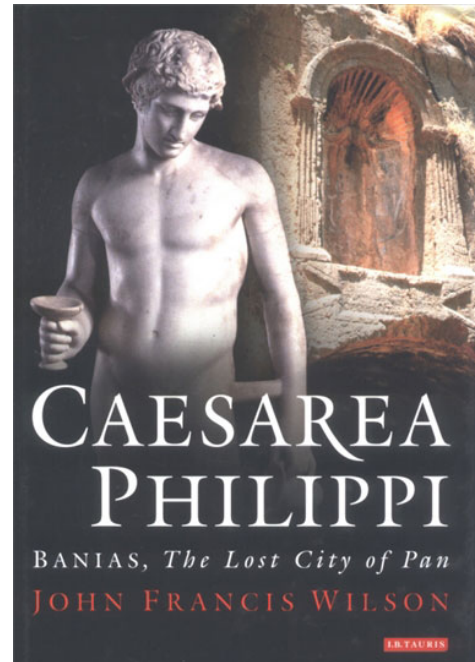


#1585 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The series of 4’s (fours) from Alexander the Great to Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 5i, Antiochus IV: The Seleucid Empire won control of Palestine with Antiochus III’s defeat of Ptolemy V at the Battle of Panium around 198 B.C., as a direct part of Syria’s fulfillment of Daniel 8:9 of waxing great toward the pleasant land

Key Understanding: The Seleucid Empire came to control Palestine upon Antiochus III’s defeat of Ptolemy V at the Battle of Panium around 198 B.C., as a direct part of Syria’s fulfillment of Daniel 8:9 of waxing great toward the pleasant land.

Daniel 8:9 (KJV) And OUT OF ONE OF THEM [the Syrian kingdom of Seleucus, or the Seleucid Empire] CAME FORTH A LITTLE HORN, which waxed EXCEEDING GREAT, toward THE SOUTH, and toward THE EAST, and toward THE PLEASANT LAND [Antiochus IV Epiphanes, but the verse should be viewed prophetically with his father, Antiochus III the Great, prominently and powerfully in the foreground].

Here is #1585–Doc 1, about the **Battle of Panium**. [Note: Most sources place the Battle of Panium in 198 B.C., but others place it in 199 B.C., and even 200 B.C. It is also called the Battle of Panias (Banias).]



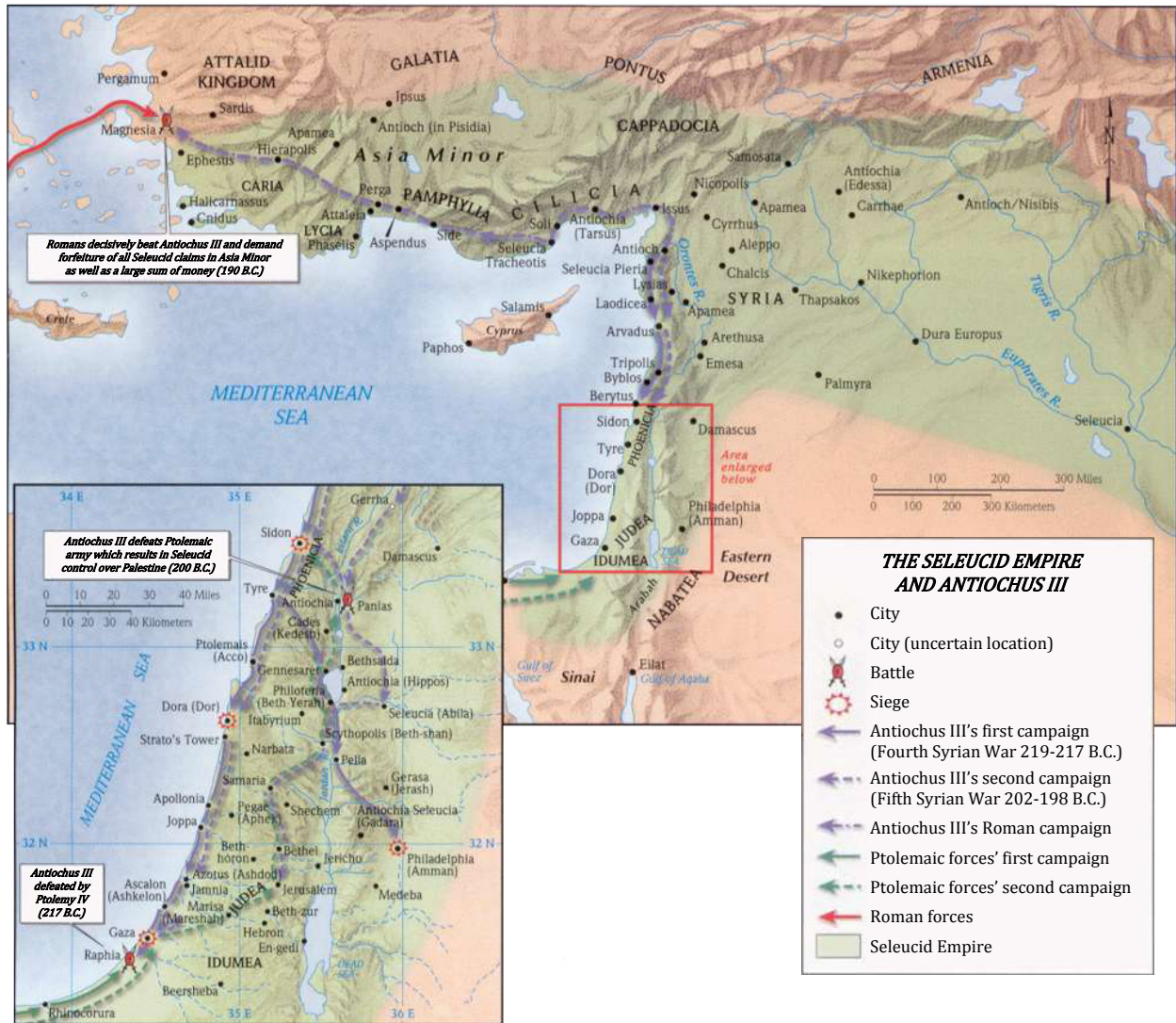
The Battle of Panium occurred at Banias, which is now called Caesarea Philippi

Below is an excellent map of the Seleucid Empire of Antiochus III the Great, with a particular emphasis on his expansion to the south against Ptolemaic Egypt. In Acrobat Reader, this map will improve for viewing when you select (by left clicking on) the magnifying glass icon (found in the upper Toolbar) marked with the “+” symbol before selecting (by left clicking) anywhere on the map that you desire to see magnified.
