
#1591 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The series of 4's (fours) from Alexander the Great to Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 50, Antiochus IV: Came Fourth a Little Horn

Key Understanding: Came fourth a little horn. Finally, we cannot miss the fact that - using sound association once again - the Lord ordained the words in the King James Version in Daniel 8:9 to read "came forth a little horn" so as to even more closely associate its fulfillment with fourth, almost as if it could read "came fourth a little horn." [Forth and fourth are homophones, words that possess different origins and meanings but are pronounced the same, whether or not they are spelled alike.] Daniel 8:9 (KJV) And OUT OF ONE OF THEM [the Syrian kingdom of Seleucus, or the Seleucid Empire] CAME FORTH A LITTLE HORN, which waxed EXCEEDING GREAT, toward THE SOUTH, and toward THE EAST, and toward THE PLEASANT LAND [Antiochus IV Epiphanes, but the verse should be viewed prophetically with his father, Antiochus III the Great, prominently and powerfully in the foreground, with the name Antiochus III the Great even reflecting the words "waxed exceeding great"].
