


Key Understanding: Through the <u>destruction</u> of the (First) Temple of Artemis (Diana) at his birth, and his offer to pay for the <u>(re)building</u> of the (Second) Temple of Artemis (Diana), Alexander the Great serves as an antichrist figure . . .

in prophetic contrast to

... the Lord's (via the Romans') <u>destruction</u> of the Jewish (Second) Temple that is seen in Matthew 24:1-2 and his building of the Living Stones (Third) Temple.

[Note: The (Second) Temple of Artemis (Diana) – which Alexander the Great had offered to help pay for the rebuilding of – would eventually be rebuilt without Alexander's aid, and was a fully completed temple by the time Paul visited Ephesus (*pictured at the top of page 1 on the right*).]

Matthew 24:1-2 (KJV) And Jesus went out, and departed from <u>THE</u> [Second] <u>TEMPLE</u>: and his disciples came to him for to shew him the buildings of <u>THE</u> [Second] <u>TEMPLE</u>. 2 And Jesus said unto them, See ye not all these things? verily I say unto you, There shall not be left here one [dead] stone [of the Second Temple] upon another [dead stone of the Second Temple], that shall not be thrown down.

Matthew 24:15 (KJV) When ye therefore shall see THE ABOMINATION OF

DESOLATION [in conjunction with the Third Temple being constructed through the joining together of the Man o' War 'Living Stones' Christian New Israel (the Body of Americans as the Third Temple) and (with) the Man o' War 'Living Stones' Jewish new Israel (the Body of Israelis as the Third Temple)], spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:)
