

Key Understanding #1 (which is the same as those of the previous two Unsealings): The Four Freedoms. Franklin D. Roosevelt's January

6, 1941, State of the Union message (Annual Message to Congress) defined his conceptions

of America's role in the world conflict and of the fundamental purpose of American democracy. The fundamental purpose of American democracy would be defined through the "Four Freedoms."



Norman Rockwell's "The Four Freedoms" paintings. President Roosevelt's Four Freedoms speech inspired a set of four paintings by Norman Rockwell. The four paintings were published in The Saturday Evening Post in 1943 on February 20 (Freedom of Speech), February 27 (Freedom of Religion), March 6 (Freedom from Want), and March 13 (Freedom from Fear). The paintings were accompanied in the magazine by matching essays on the Four Freedoms. The United States Department of the Treasury toured Rockwell's Four Freedoms paintings around the country after their publication in 1943. The Four Freedoms Tour raised over \$130,000,000 in war bond sales. Rockwell's Four Freedoms paintings were also reproduced as postage stamps by the United States Post Office.

Key Understanding #2: One of the most remarkable ordainments surrounding the *latter day(s)* fulfillment of Daniel 8:9 through Franklin D. Roosevelt's January 6, 1941, Four Freedoms is the March 13, 1943, death of Stephen Vincent Benet, which occurred on the same date as the edition of the *Saturday Evening Post* that carried his essay on Freedom from Fear. [Reference the article in Doc 2 *above*, which explains that Stephen Vincent Benet wrote an essay for the *Saturday Evening Post* to accompany the unveiling of Norman Rockwell's Freedom from Fear painting.] This will be further discussed in Unsealings <u>#1686–#1689</u>.
