Key Understanding: The official dedication of Mount Rushmore occurred on August 10, 1927, to fulfill Daniel 8:10. The official dedication of Mount Rushmore for the beginning of the work occurred during the presidency of Calvin Coolidge, at Mount Rushmore in the Black Hills of South Dakota, on August 10 (8/10), 1927, to confirm the role of Mount Rushmore in the latter day(s) fulfillment of Daniel 8:10 (as part of the overall passage of Daniel 8:9-12). Coolidge began his dedication speech with,

"We have come here to dedicate a cornerstone that was laid by the hand of the Almighty."

On August 10, 1927, a vacationing President Calvin Coolidge, clad in his Sunday best and new cowboy boots, delivers a speech at Mount Rushmore's dedication. The president presents Borglum with six drill bits to officially begin the sculpture.

President Coolidge at the dedication of Mount Rushmore, August 10, 1927. Following his opening address, Coolidge handed Gutzon Borglum a set of drills, which he then took up the mountain and used, marking the first official work on the mountain carving.

Daniel 8:10-12 (KJV) And IT WAXED GREAT [Borglum . . . a word or two of the great things we accomplished as a Nation], EVEN TO THE HOST OF HEAVEN
[Borglum . . . Hence, let us place there, carved high, as close to heaven as we can, the words of our leaders, their faces, to show posterity what manner of men they were;
