The words of Gutzon Borglum about Mount Rushmore:

"I want, somewhere in America on or near the Rockies, the backbone of the Continent, so far removed from succeeding, selfish, coveting civilizations, a few feet of stone that bears witness, carries the likenesses, the dates, a word or two of the **great things** we accomplished as a Nation, **placed so high it won't pay to pull them down for lesser purposes**. Hence, let us



place there, carved high, **as close to heaven as we can**, the words of our leaders, their faces, to show posterity what manner of men they were. **Then breathe a prayer that these records will endure until the wind and rain alone shall wear them away.**"

The Word of the Lord:

Isaiah 40:6-8 (NIV) . . . ALL MEN [the number of man is 6 or VI] are like grass, AND ALL THEIR GLORY is like the [May] FLOWERS [the roses] of the FIELD.

7 The grass withers and THE FLOWERS [the roses] FALL, because THE BREATH OF THE LORD BLOWS ON THEM. Surely the people are grass.

8 The grass withers and <u>THE FLOWERS</u> [the <u>roses</u>] <u>FALL</u>, but the word of our God stands forever."

Key Understanding: Breathing a prayer vs. the breath of the Lord. The Lord ordained the lofty words of Gutzon Borglum of "breathe a prayer that these records will endure until the wind and rain alone shall wear them away" to stand in contrast to the role that Mount Rushmore and the Roosevelts have in the fulfillment of Isaiah 40:6-8, where it is seen that "the breath of the Lord blows on them," causing them to wither and fall. Remember, the name Roosevelt is especially tied to Isaiah 40:6-8 because of its derivation from rose + field. [Reference Unsealings #1629 and #1634.]
