Gutzon Borglum's words about Mount Rushmore

... a <u>word</u> or two of the <u>great things</u> we accomplished as a Nation, <u>placed so high it won't</u> <u>pay to pull them down for lesser purposes</u>. Hence, let us place there, carved high, <u>as close</u> <u>to heaven as we can</u>, the words of our leaders, their faces, to show posterity what manner of men they were.

Key Understanding: A mouth speaking great things. The Lord ordained Gutzon Borglum to use the phrase "a <u>word</u> or two of the <u>great things</u> we accomplished as a Nation," not only in fulfillment of Daniel 8:9-12, but also as a major fulfillment of Daniel 7:8, showing that the nation that produced the Syrian Little Horn of Daniel 8:9 <u>is the same as</u> the Roman Little Horn Nation of Daniel 7:8. The words in Daniel 7:8 of "a <u>mouth speaking great things</u>" were actually written by the Lord through the hand of Daniel with the Lord specifically having in mind the future words of Gutzon Borglum – "a <u>word</u> or two of the <u>great things</u> we accomplished as a Nation." Said another way, the Lord was pointing specifically to Borglum and his words when He constructed the words in Daniel 7:8 to include "a <u>mouth speaking great things</u>." Borglum was directly fulfilling the Daniel 7:8 passage of "a <u>mouth speaking great things</u>" when he spoke of the "<u>great things</u> we accomplished as a Nation," verified not only by the content and context of his words – which were about the growth of America, which is seen in Daniel 7:8 – but by the fact that his mouth through his pen was literally speaking the words "<u>great things</u>." Borglum was fulfilling both <u>Daniel 8:9</u> and <u>Daniel 7:8</u>.

[The "<u>word</u> or two of the <u>great things</u> we accomplished as a Nation" did not end up being sculpted on the face of Mount Rushmore itself, but later became a part of the historical information included in the scaled-down version of the Hall of Records inside Mount Rushmore.]

A mouth speaking great things: The fulfillment of Daniel 7:8 through Col. John Nixon (and Gutzon Borglum)

Daniel 7:8 (KJV) I considered the [ten] horns, and behold, there came up among them another <u>LITTLE</u> <u>HORN</u> [a Fifth Beast, the United States of America], before whom there were <u>THREE OF THE FIRST</u> <u>HORNS</u> [England, France, and Spain, uprooted by Mexico in 1821, which was then uprooted by the United States in the 1846-1848 Mexican War] plucked up by the roots: and, behold, in this horn were eyes like the eyes of man, and <u>A MOUTH SPEAKING GREAT</u>

Daniel 8:9 (KJV) <u>And OUT OF ONE</u> <u>OF THEM</u> [the second Syria, the United States] <u>CAME FORTH A</u> <u>LITTLE HORN, which waxed</u> <u>EXCEEDING GREAT, toward THE</u> <u>SOUTH, and toward THE EAST, and</u> <u>toward THE PLEASANT LAND</u> [Harry Truman, through the double events of the dropping of the Pu-239 August 9, 1945, atomic bomb and the May 14-15, 1948, U.S.-recognized birth of Israel, preceded by Franklin D. Roosevelt and the Four Freedoms of

January 6, 1941, in prophetic concert



with the March 6, 1941, death of Gutzon Borglum and the pre-World War II completion of Mount Rushmore, and, finally, with the capping off of the Mount Rushmore Memorial through the completion of a scaled-down version of its Hall of Records on August 9, 1998].

Daniel 8:10-12 (KJV) And <u>IT WAXED GREAT</u> [Borglum . . . a word or two of the <u>great things</u> we accomplished as a Nation], <u>EVEN TO THE HOST OF HEAVEN</u> [Borglum . . . Hence, let us place there, carved high, <u>as close to heaven as we can</u>, the words of our leaders, their faces, to show posterity what manner of men they were]; and <u>IT CAST DOWN</u> some of the host and of the stars to the ground, and stamped upon them [Borglum . . . <u>placed</u> so high it won't pay to pull them down for lesser purposes]. 11 Yea, he magnified himself even to the prince of the host, and by him the daily sacrifice was taken away, and <u>THE PLACE OF</u> HIS [the Lord's] SANCTUARY WAS CAST DOWN.



12 And an host was given him against the daily sacrifice by reason of transgression, and it cast down the truth to the ground; and it practised, and prospered.
