

#1644 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The series of 4’s (fours) leading up to and surrounding the latter day fulfillment of Daniel 8:9 through Harry Truman and the Atomic Bomb, part 2u, Mount Rushmore: The “mouth speaking great things” correlation of the Little Horn of Daniel 7:8 with the Little Horn of Daniel 8:9

Gutzon Borglum’s words about Mount Rushmore

... a word or two of the great things we accomplished as a Nation, placed so high it won't pay to pull them down for lesser purposes. Hence, let us place there, carved high, as close to heaven as we can, the words of our leaders, their faces, to show posterity what manner of men they were.

Key Understanding: The Lord ordained Gutzon Borglum to actually use the phrase “a word or two of the great things we accomplished as a Nation,” not only to fulfill Daniel 8:9-12, but also as a major fulfillment of Daniel 7:8, showing that the nation that produced the Syrian Little Horn of Daniel 8:9 is the same as the Roman Little Horn Nation of Daniel 7:8. The words in Daniel 7:8 of “a mouth speaking great things” were actually written by the Lord through the hand of Daniel with the Lord specifically having in mind the future words of Gutzon Borglum – “a word or two of the great things we accomplished as a Nation.” Said another way, the Lord was pointing specifically to Borglum and his words when He constructed the words in Daniel 7:8 to include “a mouth speaking great things.” Borglum was literally fulfilling the Daniel 7:8 passage of “a mouth speaking great things” when he spoke of the “great things we accomplished as a Nation,” verified by not only the content and context of his speech – which was about the growth of America, which is seen in Daniel 7:8 – but by the fact that his mouth literally was speaking the words “great things.” Borglum was fulfilling both Daniel 8:9 and Daniel 7:8.

[The “word or two of the great things we accomplished as a Nation” did not end up being sculpted on the face of Mount Rushmore itself, but became a part of the historical information included in the later scaled-down version of the Hall of Records inside Mount Rushmore.]

A mouth speaking great things: The fulfillment of Daniel 7:8 through Col. John Nixon (and Gutzon Borglum)

Daniel 7:8 (KJV) I considered the [ten] horns, and behold, there came up among them another LITTLE HORN [a Fifth Beast, the United States of America], before whom there were THREE OF THE FIRST HORNS [England, France, and Spain, uprooted by Mexico in 1821, which was then uprooted by the United States in the 1846-1848 Mexican War] plucked up by the roots: and, behold, in this horn were eyes like the eyes of man, and A MOUTH SPEAKING GREAT THINGS [referring to the Declaration of Independence and its meaning and doctrines, first read publicly by a mouth (Col. John Nixon) on 7/8, in fulfillment of Daniel 7:8, and Gutzon Borglum in expressing the purpose of Mount Rushmore and in doing so using the words “the great things we accomplished as a Nation”].

A mouth speaking great things: The fulfillment of Daniel 8:9-12 through Gutzon Borglum

Daniel 8:9 (KJV) And OUT OF ONE OF THEM [the *second* Syria, the United States] ***CAME FORTH A LITTLE HORN, which waxed EXCEEDING GREAT, toward THE SOUTH, and toward THE EAST, and toward THE PLEASANT LAND*** [Harry Truman, through the double events of the dropping of the Pu-239 August 9, 1945, atomic bomb and the May 14-15, 1948, U.S.-recognized birth of Israel, preceded by Franklin D. Roosevelt and the Four Freedoms of January 6, 1941, in prophetic concert with the March 6, 1941, death of Gutzon Borglum and the pre-World War II completion of Mount Rushmore, and, finally, with the capping off of the Mount Rushmore Memorial tied to the completion of a scaled-down version of its Hall of Records on August 9, 1998].

Daniel 8:10-12 (KJV) And IT WAXED GREAT [Borglum . . . a word or two of the **great things** we accomplished as a Nation], ***EVEN TO THE HOST OF HEAVEN*** [Borglum . . . Hence, let us place there, carved high, **as close to heaven as we can**, the words of our leaders, their faces, to show posterity what manner of men they were]; ***and IT CAST DOWN some of the host and of the stars to the ground, and stamped upon them*** [Borglum . . . **placed so high it won't pay to pull them down for lesser purposes**].

11 Yea, he magnified himself even to the prince of the host, and by him the daily sacrifice was taken away, and THE PLACE OF HIS [the Lord's] ***SANCTUARY WAS CAST DOWN.***

12 And an host was given him against the daily sacrifice by reason of transgression, and it cast down the truth to the ground; and it practised, and prospered.
