Alexandria, Egypt. Alexander the Great founded Alexandria, Egypt, in 332 B.C. After he died in 323 B.C., Alexander the Great's body was taken to Memphis, Egypt, but was later carried to Alexandria, and placed in a beautiful tomb. Ptolemy, one of Alexander's generals and founder of the Egyptian dynasty known as the Ptolemies, made Alexandria the capital of Egypt. The city flourished as a center of trade and culture. The city became famous for the Lighthouse of Alexandria, which was one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Cleopatra, queen of Egypt and the last of the Ptolemies, ruled from Alexandria during the first century B.C. Her love affair with Roman

leader Mark Antony led to civil war in Rome.

Key Understanding #1: Alexander the Great. Alexander the Great, just like his Syrian

Seleucid successors, Antiochus III the Great and Antiochus IV Epiphanes, waxed great toward the south, toward the east, and toward the pleasant land.

Key Understanding #2: Alexandria. Alexandria, Egypt, a city founded by Alexander the Great and the one in which he is buried, is the testimony to Alexander the Great waxing exceeding great toward the south.

Key Understanding #3: Rudolph Hess. Rudolph Hess (who coined the phrase 'Heil Hitler!') was Deputy Fuhrer to Adolf Hitler and was considered to be the number 3 man in Nazi Germany after Herman Goering (founder of the Gestapo). Hess was born in Alexandria, Egypt.

Key Understanding #4: *Rudolf Hess and Alexandria*. The Lord ordained Rudolph Hess to be born (on April 26, 1894) in Alexandria, Egypt, because Nazi Germany's Adolf Hitler had the prophetic role as a *second* Alexander the Great.

Here is the shadow fulfillment of Daniel 8:8 by Adolf Hitler of Nazi Germany as a *second* Alexander the Great:

Daniel 8:8 (KJV) Therefore <u>THE HE GOAT</u> [Germany] <u>WAXED VERY GREAT</u>: and when he was strong, <u>THE GREAT HORN WAS BROKEN</u> [Adolf Hitler's suicide on April 30, 1945, and Nazi Germany's surrender on May 7, 1945, ending 12 years of rule]; and for it [from it] came up <u>FOUR NOTABLE ONES</u> [represented by the Four-Power Rule over post-World War II Germany by the United States, Great Britain, France, and the USSR] <u>TOWARD THE FOUR WINDS OF HEAVEN</u>.
