

#1692 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – Hitler (vs. the U.S.) waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a second Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 10, What was occurring regarding Adolf Hitler and Greece on Epiphany, January 6, 1941

Review (from the previous Unsealing): Not surprisingly, because Alexander the Great and *Greece* were at the center of the *former day(s)* fulfillment of Daniel 8:8-9, the Lord ordained the nation of *Greece* to be at the center of the *latter day(s)* fulfillment of Daniel 8:8-9, especially as concerns the weaving together of the two competing *second* Antiochus IVs Epiphanes, (i) Adolf Hitler of Nazi Germany, and (ii) the presidents of the United States of America, particularly Roosevelt and Truman.

Key Understanding #1: Furthermore, it was on Epiphany, January 6, 1941, that *Greece* was at the center of the *latter day*(s) fulfillment of Daniel 8:8-9.

On January 6, 1941, the same day that President Franklin D. Roosevelt gave the Annual Message to Congress that contained the Four Freedoms, British Prime Minister Winston Churchill announced his decision to the British chiefs of staff that Britain would make *Greece* a priority in Britain's attempt to protect the country from its current invasion by Italy and from its impending invasion by Germany, the Rome-Berlin Axis powers led by Mussolini and Hitler.






Key Understanding #2: All of this has to do with properly developing the picture of the fulfillment of prophecy of Adolf Hitler's Nazi Germany as a competing *second* Syria waxing great toward the *south* and toward the *east*, with *Greece* at the center of it all.

Daniel 8:9 (KJV) And OUT OF ONE OF THEM [the competing second Syria, Germany] CAME FORTH A LITTLE HORN [Nazi Germany's Adolf Hitler], which waxed

EXCEEDING GREAT, toward THE SOUTH, and toward THE EAST, and toward THE PLEASANT LAND.

The background. Britain was battling Italian forces in North Africa at that time – in late 1940 and early 1941 - and a decision had to be made on whether to prioritize men and resources to finish off Italy in North Africa, or to aid Greece in its battle against the Italians and its forthcoming battle with the Germans. Before we get to the details of the story, let's look at a map (in Doc 1 below) depicting the situation in North Africa (meaning Egypt and Libya), illustrating the battle between the Italian forces, led by Italian military officer Rodolfo Graziani (who initiated an Italian attack on September 13, 1940), and British forces, led by British Field Marshal Sir Archibald Wavell.
