

The Monroe Doctrine and Greek independence from the Ottoman Empire. The Greek struggle for independence from the Ottoman Empire began in 1821 and continued to unfold through the time of the issuance of the Monroe Doctrine in 1823 and during most of the decade of the 1820's. In 1827, the European powers of France, Great Britain, and Russia would intervene with force to aid the Greeks toward the gaining of their independence in 1830.

Key Understanding: The Monroe Doctrine and Greek independence from the Ottoman Empire. The Lord ordained the Monroe Doctrine's role in the U.S. waxing great toward the south in fulfillment of Daniel 8:9 to involve the circumstance of the Greek struggle for independence against the Ottoman Empire, because of Greece's prominent historical role (beginning with Alexander the Great) in the fulfillment of Daniel 8:8-9. While the U.S.'s role would be limited concerning Greek independence at that point in time, the United States would later wax great toward the east to keep Greece independent after World War II, as will be discussed.

Daniel 8:9 (KJV) <u>And OUT OF ONE OF THEM</u> [the second Syria, the United States, located in the northwest part of the world] <u>CAME FORTH A LITTLE HORN</u>, which waxed <u>EXCEEDING GREAT</u>, toward THE SOUTH [for American independence (from which came the Northwest Territory with its slave-prohibiting Northwest Ordinance) triggered the independence of Spanish colonies from Spain toward the south], <u>and toward THE EAST</u>, and toward THE PLEASANT LAND.
