
Key Understanding: The July 4, 1826, deaths of Adams and Jefferson. The Lord was confirming through (i) the Liberty Bell (which bore the inscription of Leviticus 25:10) ringing in honor of the July 4, 1776, Declaration of Independence birth of America, and (ii) the double deaths of the 2<sup>nd</sup> President of the United States, John Adams, and the 3<sup>rd</sup> President of the United States, Thomas Jefferson, on July 4, 1826, America's 50<sup>th</sup> (fiftieth) birthday, that the Little Horn Nation of America rising on July 4, 1776, represented a counterfeit jubilee for mankind.


Leviticus 25:8-10 (KJV) And THOU SHALT NUMBER SEVEN SABBATHS OF YEARS unto thee, SEVEN TIMES SEVEN YEARS; and the space of **THE SEVEN SABBATHS OF YEARS** shall be unto thee forty and nine years.
